FEATURING DR. ALAN COTNEY



Dr. Alan Cotney, our lead pastor, is happy to be called Pastor Alan. His wife, Beth and their children Will, Emma, Drew, Kate and Bela are a blessing to College Road Baptist Church. In a recent interview he cited Jeremiah 20:9 that gave him the passion for teaching and preaching God's Word. At a college retreat in 1998 he finally surrendered to God's call on his life. He said that he had been running from God's call until that weekend. After surrendering to God's call, he had some opportunities to lead and preach and that's when God confirmed that He was calling him to a life of preaching and teaching.

He was licensed to preach on August 30, 1998. Earning a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration from Samford University in 2002, he obtained a Master of Divinity in Biblical Languages in 2005 and received a Doctor of Ministry in 2014, both from Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary in Wake Forest, NC. Since he became the Lead Pastor of CRBC on July 8, 2013, the church and our ministries have continued to grow. Pastor Alan cited the fact that the congregation as a whole has transitioned from "missionallyminded" to "missionally-active." The diversity of cultures that has evolved in our local area has given opportunities to minister as a church, with people inviting others to gather for worship and ministry.

Matthew 25:38-40 "And when did we see You a stranger, and invite You in...The King will answer and say to them, 'Truly I say to you, to the extent that you did it to one of these brothers of Mine, even the least of them, you did it to Me."

Overcoming the language barriers that exist for strangers in a foreign land is a great challenge. It can be overwhelming to develop communication skills when transitioning from one's home country to a new country. The Florida Baptist Convention churches, of which College Road is a member, are given the privilege and responsibility to help our international neighbors develop these skills.

The number of people in Ocala who want to learn to speak English is increasing rapidly. This gives us the opportunity to demonstrate and share God's love with our non-English speaking neighbors through ESL. The primary goal of ESL ministries is to intentionally share and demonstrate the Gospel of Jesus Christ as we help people learn to speak English.

At College Road we teach "conversational" English to any non-English speaking adult.
Students are placed in one of three levels based on their proficiency. Last year we averaged 25 students weekly.
Volunteer teachers are always welcome. You do not need to be bi-lingual to teach. In fact, only English is to be spoken in the classroom.

Our classes are Wednesday nights from 6:30 to 7:45 PM and will begin September 11. Anyone interested in volunteering can reach me, Deb Simmons, at 601-814-0423.
