Stay Connected to Jesus

Read: John 15:1-17

Main idea: True disciples of Jesus Christ have a permanent, life-giving, fruit-producing union with their Savior and Lord.

Key Verses: "I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers; and the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned." **(15:5-6 ESV)**

Key Principles:

- Jesus is preparing His disciples for His upcoming death, resurrection and ascension by explaining what it means to be a true disciple.
- The vine and branch illustration points to the simple truth that being connected to Jesus brings life and that life is revealed by producing righteous fruit.
- The righteous fruit that Jesus describes looks like answered prayer, obedient love, inexhaustible joy and sacrificial love.
- Apart from being connected to Jesus and His life we can accomplish nothing for God
- If there is no fruit, then there is no connection to God through Jesus by the Spirit.
- God does not hide in His children; the evidence of His presence will always be noticeable.

Discussion:

- 1. Why do you think Jesus calls Himself the vine and His followers the branches? What does that illustration mean for you and your life?
- 2. What are some of the forms that spiritual fruit takes in the life of a believer? What fruit is evident in your life?
- 3. If Jesus is the true vine, what do you think are false vines? How would the world see this as a divisive message?
- 4. How might God's commitment to your fruit bearing change how you respond to different events in your life? How can you stay connected to Jesus?
- 5. What does your prayer life look like today? Are you praying in confidence of answered prayer? Why or why not?
- 6. What is the difference between obedience to earn love and obedience as the evidence of love? Which option do you find yourself leaning towards?

Prayer:

- Pray that we would stay connected to Jesus through the Spirit for a fruitful life.
- Pray:
 - That we remember that we can do nothing without the power and presence of God.
 - That we would be obedient to the will of God because of His love for us.
 - That we heed the warning of Christ to bear fruit by sharing the gospel with everyone.
