The Grace of Giving

Read: 2 Corinthians 8:10-9:5

Main idea: We must be dedicated to giving as individuals and as a church so that gospel ministry can continue to go forth in our city and around the world.

Key Verses: "So I thought it necessary to urge the brothers to go on ahead to you and arrange in advance for the gift you have promised, so that it may be ready as a willing gift, not as an exaction." **(9:5 ESV)**

Key Principles:

- Generosity should flow from a willing heart that understands the importance of giving, not from reluctance or pressure.
- Generosity honors a commitment from believers to give eagerly and to showcase integrity and faithfulness.
- Generosity serves as an example to others that inspires them to act by giving towards God's work as well.
- Giving generously shows faith in God's ability to provide and mirrors the grace that we've received in Christ.
- Preparation is key to ensuring that giving is joyful and intentional, not rushed or begrudging.

Discussion:

- 1. Why do you think Paul stresses preparation and willingness in giving? How does this apply to us today?
- 2. Why should giving not be done under pressure? What is the proper motivation for giving?
- 3. In what ways can generosity demonstrate faithfulness to God's mission?
- 4. How have you seen examples of one person's or group's generosity inspiring others to give? If you give, what or whom inspired you to start giving?
- 5. Why is it important to honor commitments in our giving? What does this teach us about integrity?
- 6. How does trusting God's provision free us to give more generously?
- 7. What steps can you take to prepare your heart and resources for generosity?

Praver:

- Pray for a heart that gives willingly and joyfully, trusting God to meet every need.
- Pray:
 - That we would follow through with our commitments in ministry and missions.
 - That our giving would inspire others to support God's work through giving.
 - That we would remember God's abundant grace in blessing us with all we have.
