

## The Coming Hour

**Read:** John 2:1-12

**Main Idea:** Jesus transforms the ordinary into the extraordinary, offering us hope and joy through His presence in our lives.

**Key Verses:** “This, the first of his signs, Jesus did at Cana in Galilee, and manifested his glory. And his disciples believed in him.” (2:11 ESV)

### Key Principles:

- Jesus meets our needs when we trust Him, often in ways that exceed our expectations, revealing His divine power.
- Obedience to Christ’s word, even when it seems unclear, unleashes His transformative power in our lives.
- Faith in Jesus grows as we witness His glory, moving us from mere observation to deep belief in His saving purpose.
- This sign points to Jesus as the Messiah who brings the abundant joy of God’s kingdom, surpassing the old ways of ritual.
- Christ’s presence turns everyday moments into opportunities for His grace and glory to shine.
- Our response to Jesus—trust, obedience, and belief—shapes our relationship with Him and our witness to the world.

### Discussion:

1. When you’ve faced a situation where you felt out of options, how did you decide whether to bring it to Jesus? What happened when you did—or didn’t?
2. How do you think Jesus’ bigger plan for His life might affect the way He responds to our requests today? What does that mean for how we approach Him?
3. Have you ever felt prompted to follow Jesus’ lead in a way that didn’t make sense at first? How did stepping out in obedience turn out for you?
4. Where in your life do you see ordinary moments or struggles that could use a touch of Jesus’ transforming power? How might that change your perspective?
5. What’s an experience you’ve had—maybe from reading the Bible or seeing God work—that strengthened your trust in who Jesus really is? How did it impact your faith?

### Prayer:

- Pray that you would Grow in trust, obedience, and faith in Jesus’ transforming power.
- Pray for:
  - Hearts that trust Jesus with every need, that are confident in His timing and ways.
  - A willingness to obey His word, even when it stretches our understanding.
  - Eyes to see His glory in our daily lives, strengthening our faith and joy in Him.
