Trusting in God's Promises

Read: Deuteronomy 7:1-11

Main Idea: Trusting in God's promises leads to an empowered life in obedience and faith, fortified by the assurance of His presence and faithfulness.

Key Verses: "Know therefore that the Lord your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations." **(7:9 ESV)**

Key Principles:

- God's sovereign power clears the way for His people, empowering us to trust Him over human strength.
- Faith resists worldly compromise, guarding our exclusive covenant with God.
- · We remove idols by trusting God's purpose, not our merit, as His holy people.
- Recalling God's faithful love strengthens our obedience, rooted in His unchanging promise.
- Obedience to God's commands reflects trust in His steadfast love, promising blessing over judgment.
- In Christ, God's promises find ultimate fulfillment, securing our faith through His victory.

Discussion:

- 1. How does trusting God's power change how we face overwhelming challenges today? Share a time God's strength surprised you.
- 2. Why does God forbid covenants and intermarriage? How would that relate to today? What modern "alliances" tempt us to compromise, and how do we resist them?
- 3. What "idols" distract us from His purpose, and how can we practically remove them?
- 4. How does God's choice of Israel "because the Lord loves you" build your trust in Him? Share a story of His faithfulness in your life or family.
- 5. Deuteronomy 7:9-11 ties God's steadfast love to our obedience—how does this promise encourage you to live differently? What steps can we take to trust Him more?

- Praise God for His sovereign power, faithful love, and kept promises.
- Prav:
 - For trust in God's strength to overcome obstacles, relying on His victory, not ours.
 - For discernment to resist worldly compromises, staying true Him.
 - For courage to remove idols, living as His holy people set apart for His purpose.
