Living in Light of Eternity

Read: 2 Corinthians 5:1-10

Main idea: Eternal perspective empowers us to live boldly today, anchored in the hope of our eternal home with Christ.

Key Verses: "Therefore we are always confident and know that while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord, for we walk by faith, not by sight." **(2 Corinthians 5:6-7, ESV)**

Key Principles:

- The temporary nature of our earthly bodies points us to the eternal, God-given resurrection body awaiting us.
- The Holy Spirit's presence is a divine guarantee, assuring us of God's promise of eternal life.
- Living by faith, not sight, enables us to navigate life's challenges with courage and hope in Christ's return.
- Our actions in this life matter, as we will all stand before Christ's judgment seat to give an account.
- An eternal perspective frees us from worldly distractions and empowers us to share the gospel boldly.
- Groaning for our heavenly home reflects a God-given longing for full redemption, not despair.

Discussion:

- 1. How does the imagery of verse 1 help you understand the difference between your current life and the eternal life promised? Share a moment when this hope sustained you through hardship.
- 2. What substitutes have you been tempted to pursue, and how can focusing on Christ as the only way to understand everything redirect your priorities?
- 3. What in this world makes you "groan" for eternity, and how does this longing, as fuel your hope rather than despair?
- 4. How does this assurance encourage you to trust God's plan when life feels overwhelming? What helps you experience the Spirit's transforming power daily?
- 5. How does this motivate you to live faithfully now? Are there specific choices or habits you feel called to align more with pleasing Christ?
- 6. How have you seen trusting God's promises lead to specific acts of obedience in your life? Share an example.

Prayer:

- Pray for guidance to live by faith, not sight, trusting God's promises amid life's trials.
- Pray for:
 - Courage to obey God's commands as an expression of faith in all you do.
 - That your LifeGroup members will find hope from an eternal perspective.
 - Boldness to share the eternal hope of Christ and His love with others.
